



DMW COPE Nursery Arrival/Dismissal Plan

DAILY HEALTH SCREENING AT ENTRY FOR FAMILIES

- Parents/guardians must take their child's temperature before coming to the facility and monitor them for all signs of illness and/or fever.
- We will conduct a daily wellness screening upon arrival of every child.
 - Parents will be asked to confirm that the child does not have fever, shortness of breath or cough.
 - They will be asked to confirm that no one in the home is exhibiting these symptoms and have not been.
- If a child shows visible symptoms of being sick, they will not be allowed into the nursery until a wellness check has been completed by the school nurse; the student will go to the isolation room to avoid exposing anyone to COVID-19.

DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP TO MAINTAIN PHYSICAL DISTANCING

- Nursery students will enter the classrooms using the doors in the center courtyard. This excludes the Butterfly Nursery that will continue using the main door in the west hallway. Students will not enter the nursery rooms.
- Parents must wear a mask and adhere to the social distancing markers remaining separate until a staff member meets them at the door.
 - Nursery personnel will receive the child and bring them into the classroom.
 - All infants and children will immediately have their hands and face washed upon entering the nursery.
 - Diaper bags will be tagged and placed onto the class cart to be sanitized before being brought into the room. For the time being, parents are encouraged to not bring a bag or at least minimize the size of the bag to accommodate only necessary items.
- In the presence of the parent, a nursery caregiver will record arrival and departure times in place of parent signatures.
 - At this time, the sign-in/out written log will not be utilized. Students will be checked-in/out using the electronic barcodes on their student ID cards or using individualized QR Codes. Parents will receive a timestamped email recording their child's acceptance into the nursery and their pick-up at the end of the day.
- Only nursery staff, the site principal, and on-campus medical personnel will be allowed to enter the nursery.
- In the case of inclement weather, drop-off will take place in the west hallway for all classrooms with the same social distancing and safety procedures in place. Pick-up will follow the school's designated "Rainy Day Procedures" with parents dismissed by arriving transportation. After the parent's bus number is called, they will pick their child up from the nursery using the doors in the west hallway.
